Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of "DFL Fabrics Private Limited" which comprises the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2020, the Statement of Profit and Loss and statement of cash flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid financial statements give the information required by the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at March 31, 2020, and profit and its cash flows for the year ended on that date.

Basis for opinion

Emphasis of Matters

1. Application of IND AS-109 "Financial Instruments" requires all the investment to be recognized at Fair value OCI which decreased value of investment to extend of Rs 33,40,732.

2. During the course of the audit we are informed that the Memorandum of Association (MOA) OR Articles of Association (AOA) doesn't include the clause to do trading of shares or of Futures & Option. Though it is not authorized by MOA or AOA Company has been trading on the same.

Information other than the Financial Statements and Auditor's Report thereon

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the other information. The other information comprises the management discussion & analysis and director's report included in the annual report but does not include the financial statements and our auditor's report thereon. The above information is expected to be made available to us after the date of this auditor's report.

Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon.

In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information identified above when it becomes available and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated.

When we read the above other information, if we conclude that there is a material misstatement therein, we are required to communicate the matter to those charged with governance.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements
